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

Executive Summary

The purpose of this independent recommendations report to Kiama Municipal Council (Council) is to support Council's decision making around major events. The focus of its recommendations are on reducing negative impacts from major events on the community, and increasing the benefits of major events for the community.

Major events are those events which have a number of the following features:

- Attracts 3,000+ attendees to a gathering in one location at one time
- · Over half of attendees are from outside Kiama LGA
- · Direct economic impact is \$1 million or more
- Multiple potential impacts on residents that require management
- · Attracts national and state media exposure
- Attracts funding from state or federal government or commercial partners

The past 18 months saw an increase in approval applications for major events, and several major events took place close to Kiama town centre in close succession during the busier months of November 2023 to April 2024, Kiama's peak and shoulder tourism seasons. The increase in major events, and the cumulative impact from several major events close together, resulted in increased impacts on the community than are normally experienced from major events held in Kiama.

A review of major events recently held in Kiama LGA revealed the following key gaps:

- A fit for purpose major event venue away from residential areas
- · Sufficient accommodation including camping

- · An event friendly approval process
- A major event assessment framework that supports strategic decision making
- · Maximising benefits from major events
- Environmentally sustainable practices at major events
- Park and ride, and public transport options
- Noise management to reduce impacts on residents (such as facing the stage at the Showgrounds to reduce wind carrying sound to residential areas)
- Communication to ensure Kiama town residents are aware of upcoming events, and the benefits provided by major events.


The report provides recommendations on how Council can better achieve organisational objectives via major events, reduce their negative impacts, and increase their benefits for the community by

- Using an event assessment framework to support decision making
- Updating the roles and budget allocation of the Events Team
- · Streamlining the event approval process
- · Developing fit for purpose major event venues
- Continuing to support and empower major events
- Maximising the social and economic benefits from major events

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Kiama Municipal Council (Council) engaged regional tourism development consultancy Tilma Group to undertake a review of major events held in the Kiama Local Government Area (LGA). The purpose of this resulting independent recommendations report is to support Council's decision making around major events.


Developing A Council Community Events Policy: A Toolkit For NSW Councils defines an event as "any organised activity that takes place wholly or partly on public land (including roads, footpaths, parks, Council venues and sports grounds) that requires approval from Council and/or other government agencies. The scale of some events may require the lodgement of a development application under the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979."

Kiama Major Events Impact Review Report and Reccomendations | 7



This review of the impacts and benefits of Kiama LGA's major events was instigated by an increase in approval applications for large scale events in the past 18 months. Additionally, several major events took place close to Kiama town centre in close succession during the busier months of November to April, Kiama's peak and shoulder tourism seasons. The increase in major events, and the cumulative impact from several major events close together, resulted in increased impacts from events on the community.

Factors that contributed to the recent increase in major events include the following.

- The addition of two new annual music concerts. resulting in four events of over 5,000 attendees taking place in Kiama LGA in a year instead of the usual two annual events of this size.
- A change of date for three major events, moving them into the 2023-24 summer tourism season (events that would normally be held outside of December-February).
- Around half a million dollars in state and federal funding secured by Kiama event organisers, and a quarter of a million dollars in state funding secured by Council, supporting the delivery of major events.
- \$49,000 in funding provided to major events by Council through its Destination Event Funding Program, supporting the delivery of major events.

Additionally, the success experienced over the 2023/24 season for major events in their first year, has built the desire of the event's organisers to continue to hold major events in Kiama and/or to aim to grow attendees at their future annual events.

The power of major events

Major events are catalysts for economic benefits for their host communities, and are deceptively effective creators of local jobs.1

Events are a great strategy to grow a local visitor economy as they are important drivers of tourism into regional areas. Three-quarters of event attendees would not have gone to a destination, if not for an event. For 57% of first-time visitors and 69% of repeat visitors to a destination, an event is the main reason for visiting, and most event attendees intend to return to the host destination in

Attendees become destination advocates through word of mouth promotion: 59% of attendees provide positive word of mouth recommendations of the event to others, and 42% of the destination.3 Events can position a destination; and boost the awareness of the destination as a centre of sport, arts, culture or industry.4

Events also build community. They bring together young and old, and disparate subcultures; they enlarge social networks and encourage social cohesion. They support charities, providing opportunities to raise funds. Events provide communities with resilience during times of hardship, and catalyse communities in the name of fun.5

The purpose of the major events review is as follows.

- To better understand the impacts of major events, and the community's view and experience of major events
- To ensure Kiama LGA has an appropriate and prosperous calendar of major events that strikes a sustainable balance for positive social and economic benefits, and community expectations on town amenity.
- To identify how to streamline approvals, and workflow for Council teams related to the delivery of major events.
- To identify which major events Council should support, and how.

This report provides recommendations that

- deliver social and economic value to the community without crossing the threshold of negative impacts to residents' quality of life.
- attract high value visitation for events, and strengthen Kiama LGA's reputation as a vibrant destination for events.
- activate the most appropriate locations.
- provide direction for Council in supporting, attracting and delivering a balanced event calendar that provides value to the community, is appealing to high value visitors, and adds value to the visitor economy in low and shoulder seasons.
- help achieve the objectives in Council's Community Strategic Plan.
- provide structure for decisions relating to major event approvals.

The report

- compiles qualitative and quantitative data relating to the positive and negative impacts of major events held in the Kiama LGA on the community. It documents sentiment of attendees, residents, local businesses, and other key stakeholders to provide Council with information to understand which types of major events provide the greatest benefit to the community, and therefore support decision making.
- reviews comparative Councils' event support practices.
- reviews Council's roles in major events, including administration of a funding program, delivering major events, and community-Council partnerships, and provides recommendations on areas of focus for Council's Events Team.

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The following process was undertaken by Tilma Group in the review of major events, and development of this report.

- Undertook relevant desktop research (see Appendix 6.2 for details).
- Developed event impact measures for improved consistency of comparison across Kiama LGA's major events.
- Audited existing major events and major event infrastructure in Kiama LGA.
- Undertook focus group consultation of major event stakeholders, gaining insights from Council staff and external stakeholders (see Appendix 6.1 for details).
- Undertook major event attendee and resident surveys (including of business owners), capturing quantitative and qualitative data on recently-held major events.
- Summarised learnings (see Appendices 6.3-6.5).
- Analysed the value of the current major events calendar, the benefits and impacts of major events, the limitations of major event venues, and the challenges of balancing resident amenity with economic and social benefit.
- Developed a Findings and Discussion Paper and received feedback on proposed recommendations from a Project Steering Group comprised of six industry representatives and one Council employee.
- Developed a draft report and received feedback from the Project Steering Group and Councillors.

· Developed a final report.

A legacy of this methodology is a structure for surveys of major event attendees that will provide consistent data to compare events over time if Council continues to survey major event attendees, or share the survey structure with major event organisers for their use. Gathering such data will support a clearer understanding of Kiama LGA's events, and will support the securing of funding for major events from grants and strategic partnerships.


Strategic alignment

Major events help Council achieve the objectives in its key guiding documents, demonstrating the importance of major events in supporting the community, local economy, and organisation.

Major events held in Kiama LGA

- Support local economic growth and provide diversity in tourism offerings.
- Provide opportunities to participate, and for social connectedness, community cohesion, a sense of belonging, and a flourishing of social and cultural life, and help residents love where they live.
- · Showcase the natural environment.
- · Build an intention to return at a later date in visitors.

4.1 Kiama community and destination

The destination

Kiama is a 90-minute drive south of Sydney and is approximately three hours north east of Canberra. Its hero experiences include seaside lifestyle, blowholes and surf, a dramatic coastline and wildlife, mountain lookouts and views of lush dairy valleys, and being a family destination. It has a sporting and surf culture, and an arts, culture and music scene.

As tourism is one of Kiama LGA's largest economic drivers, it benefits from an established and engaged

tourism industry who serve 1.3 million visitors each year. The peak visitation period is within school holiday periods over summer and autumn, particularly in January. Off peak is considered March-November, outside of school and public holidays. However, accommodations tend to be at high occupancy on weekends year-round.

"We value the role of tourism as the life blood of our local economy. We also at times struggle with the consequences of this focus on tourism, especially, but not exclusively, the impacts of the massive influx of visitors in holiday periods on parking, service, and access. We therefore wish to build on our strengths as a destination of choice and mitigate against its sometimes unintended consequences.

We recognise that if we want to build a future for our young people now we need to look at new possibilities and new ways of doing things. In that regard, we see great potential in the development of the arts, festivals and cultural activities both for their inherent contribution to community, and also for their capacity to reshape and expand the attraction and marketing of our area to visitors and to our young people."

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The community

The community has a reputation as a retirement community, although the LGA has almost twice as many residents of working age as retired residents (11,638 residents aged 20-64 and 6,366 residents aged 65 or older) and an almost an equal number of youth and children as retirees (5,129 residents aged up to 19)6. Council recognises the importance of engaging youth to stay in the region.

Visitors

870,000 visitors to Kiama are daytrippers, often coming from Sydney by train or highway, while 400,000 domestic visitors stay overnight. 67% of visitors come for a holiday, and 19% to visit local friends and relatives. Most visitors come as a couple, and the most common age groups that visit are 25-34 and 45-54. Visitors average spend per visit is \$517.7

For overnight visitors to the NSW South Coast who visit to attend festivals, and cultural and sporting events, their average stay is three nights (similar to the average length of stay for all overnight visitors to Kiama), and their average expenditure is \$618 per trip or \$208 per night,8 which is 9% higher than the average spend for all overnight visitors to Kiama of \$568 per trip9.

4.2 Venues for major events

The venues in the table below have been identified by Council as major event venues. However, Kiama does not have a purpose-built major event venue and most of the venues used to host major events are shared spaces with a competing first priority, such as sportsfields.

A purpose built or priority major event venue would have the following qualities.

- Development Approval for major events of a certain type with certain conditions
- · Located away from residents
- Not a sportsground where the grounds and underground infrastructure have high protection needs

- On-site camping
- Public and active transport access
- Parking
- Fenced
- · Three-phase power in suitable locations
- Toilets
- Lighting
- Stage
- Water refill stations
- · Undercover protection for inclement weather

The absence of these features results in additional costs for event organisers.

"The lack of suitable sites...and the cost and complexity of using a greenfield site discourages commercial operators from organising large events, festivals or concerts, and makes it difficult for community groups working with volunteers to maintain the continuity of festivals.

Available sites have an existing educational, environmental, rural, recreational, sporting or racing focus that make it extremely difficult to organise festivals without conflicting with the existing activities and practices. In addition, many sites are controlled by multi-users, requiring concurrent but separate negotiation for the use of their facilities."

4.3 Major events


Annual calendar of events

In the 2023/24 spring and summer the calendar of major events as depicted below was different than normal, with more major events than normal taking place in close succession from October to March, and with more events than normal from December to February. This was because

- two new major music festivals were held (though the event organisers' original dates were in November and April)
- three major events were pushed into the 2023-24 summer season that would normally be held outside of December to February (the two new events and one annual event).

Holding several major events close to each other has cumulative negative impacts on residents as well as negative impacts on ticket sales.

- Only two major events normally take place in the busiest tourism months, neither of which include amplified music
- There is an opportunity to host major events in the off peak tourism season to spread their impact more evenly
 across the year, giving residents a respite between major events. However, having no major events in these
 months also provides residents with a respite.

Major events impact review

Following is a summary of the features and impacts of major events held in Kiama LGA.

This is a summary of a detailed audit undertaken as part of this major event impact review. The audit includes qualitative and quantitative data relating to the positive and negative impacts of major events held in Kiama LGA on the community and on local businesses, and the sentiments of attendees. The audit compiled data from a range of sources, including post-event reports, attendee survey, REMPLAN economic impact reports, media reports, and discussions with stakeholders.

According to REMPLAN, the estimated economic impact of each these major events ranges from \$0.1m to \$2m. The event with the biggest estimated economic impact is Changing Tides, with approximately \$2 million in economic impact.

Unfortunately, data is not available to compare the economic impact of major Kiama events business to other types of major Kiama businesses. Such a comparison would enable Council to understand the value of major events in the context of other businesses with major benefits for the local economy.

For two of the major events held in Kiama LGA recently¹³, an attendee survey provided rich data. Unfortunately, surveys for some of the other recent major events were not distributed effectively and the opportunity to collect information from attendees was not realised.

Kiama Jazz and Blues Festival and SurfLife are different from the major events held in Kiama LGA as they attract fewer attendees and spread the impact of their attendees across several venues and several days, rather than being a mass gathering at one venue at the same time.

This model of major events better suits Kiama's event venues and accommodation availability, and reduces negative impacts on residents.

13 Changing Tides and NYE Sky Show

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This review revealed that the majority of major events do not support the pillar in Council's Community Strategic Plan of 'Thrive in a sustainable environment'. There is an opportunity for Council to support the improved environmental sustainability of major events (including those run by Council), as well as to leverage major events to engage the public in making environmentally sustainable choices.

Cost vs benefit

Both Council staff and residents expressed concerns regarding the broader implications extending beyond the event venue and/or the event day. Examples include ratepayers subsidising commercial events through wear and tear on ratepayer-funded venues, costs to repair wet weather impacted sportsgrounds (which can be more than the bond event organisers pay), and additional staff costs to deliver waste management services outside of the venue (e.g. to clean up after free camping attendees using public toilets and bins). The Director of Infrastructure & Liveability would like to have funds to improve Council-managed venues over time, rather than see them degrade.

Decision making can be informed through an understanding of the direct impact of major events on the local economy. With this information, Councillors can decide if they would like all costs to ratepayers recouped through either fees to event organisers, through user-pays systems (such as fees on event tickets or parking fees for visitors). Alternatively, Council may opt to subsidise major events that make substantial contributions to the local economy, or align with Council's objectives outlined in its Community Strategic Plan.

It is to be noted that if Council opts to recoup all costs through fees to event organisers, it is likely that such fees added to the significant increased costs that event organisers are currently facing would reduce the number of major events held in Kiama LGA, and thereby reduce their benefits for the community.

If Council elects to support events that bring significant benefits to the community, it is recommended that Council

- proactively maximise the benefits the community receives from such major events (see Actions below for suggestions)
- communicate to ratepayers the value of this support, such as by articulating the contributions of each funded major event's contribution to the local economy, and its other specific economic, social and/or cultural benefits for residents.
