MINUTES OF THE KIAMA LOCAL TRANSPORT FORUM

4 AUGUST 2026

That a No Stopping Zone be installed along the western side of Tasman Drive Gerringong, in daylight hours between 10.00am and 8.00pm, to allow sufficient space for cars travelling in either direction to pass each other safely during the busy visitation period of the day. The No Stopping zone will include a continuous yellow line along the western side of Tasman Drive. In addition to the continuous yellow line, Council will install No Stopping signage which will include the times. This arrangement should be revisited in 12 months, in the event that the busy activity subsides.

It was noted that it is currently a No Parking zone on the corner of Belinda Street and Tasman Drive, as it is line marked with double lines. However, due to people continuing to park on this corner and blocking the road causing traffic flow issues, a yellow line will be implemented on the sides of the road to reinforce it as no parking.

Drones in the area should be reported to the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA), as Council is not the regulating body for drones.
